Post Construction termite, treatment is available for buildings that experience termite damage after the warranty period has expired.

This type of treatment involves drilling through the concrete floor slab or drilling from the outside through the outer wall so that the termiticide can be applied to the compacted soil below the floor slab

This type of work can be disruptive due to the noise and dust generated by the drilling work and the treatment is more expensive than pre construction treatment but very effective and necessary if you are experiencing termite infestations in your home or work place. A warranty is also available for this type of treatment

Termite treatment is also now being included in the construction phase of roads.

Subterranean termites build very large nests that can extend below the road surface. If these tunnels collapse it could result in an uneven road surface which will ultimately need to be repaired.

Experience indicates that "spot" treatment of affected sections is effective but termites still appear in sections that were not treated. For this reason there is now a belief that a full "blanket" treatment of the entire road length is the best approach.

This form of treatment will protect the entire road length and together with regular maintenance of the road reserve should ensure a termite free environment for many years.
